### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITIES AND TOWNS TO PAY PERMANENT EMPLOYEES OVERTIME.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The cities and towns of the commonwealth are  
2 hereby authorized to pay permanent employees over-  
3 time, when such overtime is the result of instructions  
4 from their superior. Such overtime shall be paid to  
5 the employee on the following pay day. The superior  
6 instructing the employee to work overtime shall in-  
7 form the paying authority of the amount of overtime  
8 in sufficient time so that payment can be made on  
9 the following pay day.
