### AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE SIZE AND WEIGHT OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section thirty, chapter ninety of the General Laws,  
2 is hereby amended to read:—The weight of com-  
3 mercial vehicles be based on a formula  $W$  equals  $C$   
4  $(L$  plus 40) with a minimum axle load of twenty-two  
5 thousand pounds. Where spacing of axle is less than  
6 eighteen feet  $C$  equals 750; where spacing of axle is  
7 eighteen feet and over  $C$  equals 850.
