RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A STUDY AND INVESTIGATION BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF ESTABLISHING A WOMEN AND MINORS DIVISION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of
2 one member of the senate to be designated by the
3 president thereof, three members of the house of rep-
4 resentatives to be designated by the speaker thereof
5 and three persons to be appointed by the governor,
6 is hereby established for the purpose of making an
7 investigation and study of the functions of the divi-
8 sion of industrial safety and the division of minimum
9 wage of the department of labor and industries with
10 a view to determining the need or advisability of
11 establishing within said department a division to be
12 known as the women and minors division. In mak-
13 ing its study and investigation hereunder, said com-
14 mission shall also make a study and investigation of
15 the powers and duties of the assistant commissioner
