By Mr. James E. Sullivan of Boston, petition of the Massachusetts State Employees Association that employees of the Commonwealth be reimbursed for the expense of operating their motor vehicles in connection with employment or duties. Public Service.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE COMMONWEALTH EMPLOYEES FOR THE EXPENSE OF OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE IN CONNECTION WITH EMPLOYMENT OR DUTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 General Laws, chapter twenty-nine, is hereby
2 amended by inserting therein the following new sec-
3 tion:—

4 *Section 26A.* An employee of the commonwealth
5 who uses a motor vehicle in connection with his em-
6 ployment or duties with the specific or general au-
7 thorization of his superiors shall be reimbursed at the
8 rate of nine cents a mile for the first one hundred
9 miles a month and thereafter at the rate of six cents
10 a mile.
