AN ACT AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CORRUPT PRACTICES LAW RELATIVE TO THE ACTIVITIES OF CERTAIN CORPORATIONS WHEN AFFECTED BY INITIATIVE PETITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section seven of chapter fifty-five of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section one of
3 chapter two hundred and seventy-three of the acts
4 of nineteen hundred and forty-three, is hereby further
5 amended by adding at the end the following sentence:
6 — Expenditures permitted by this section shall in
7 each case be limited to twenty-five thousand dollars.
