### AN ACT TO REGULATE AND CONTROL INSURANCE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In any contract of life insurance, when  
2 an agent of an insurance company calls at the resi-  
3 dence or abode of a policyholder to collect premiums  
4 on a life insurance policy it shall be deemed that the  
5 place of payment of the premiums on the policy is at  
6 the residence or abode of the policyholders.

1 SECTION 2. That failure of the payment of a  
2 premium on a life insurance policy shall not cause the  
3 policy to lapse at any time if the agent fails to call or  
4 contact the assured.
