AN ACT PROVIDING FOR BILLS OF EXCEPTIONS IN PROBATE PROCEEDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section nine of chapter two hundred and fifteen of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary
3 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end the
4 following new sentence: — In lieu of an appeal a par-
5 son aggrieved may file a bill of exceptions as pro-
6 vided in chapter two hundred and thirty-one, section
7 one hundred and thirteen.
