## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Five.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CITATIONS FOR VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A suitable citation of appreciation,  
2 signed by the governor, shall be issued by the com-  
3 monwealth of Massachusetts to every Massachusetts  
4 veteran of World War II who is honorably discharged  
5 or released from the service of the United States.

1 SECTION 2. Veterans presently discharged or re-  
2 leased from service shall be issued citations within  
3 ninety days after the passage of this act, and every  
4 other veteran or the next of kin of a deceased veteran  
5 may receive such citation upon application to his  
6 local veterans center.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
