AN ACT RELATIVE TO OPENING OF BALLOT BOXES DURING VOTING HOURS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No town shall be permitted to open the ballot
- 2 boxes or count any votes before their voting places
- 3 actually close.
