AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HOURS OF WORK REQUIRED OF AN EMPLOYEE IN ANY ONE WEEK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No person, except those engaged in interstate
- 2 business, shall be required to work more than forty
- 3 hours in any one week. Violations of this act shall be
- 4 punished by a fine of not more than one hundred
- 5 dollars.
