The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Five.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE INTERVIEWING BY INVESTIGATORS OF PARTIES OR WITNESSES IN CONNECTION WITH AN ACCIDENT WITHIN A PERIOD OF FIFTEEN DAYS AFTER SUCH ACCIDENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No officer or employee of an insurance company or
2 any other person engaged by an insurance, adjust-
3 ment or investigating company or agency shall inter-
4 view any person in connection with any accident or
5 claim for damages arising out of an accident for a
6 period of fifteen days after such accident occurred.
7 Violation of this section shall be punished by a fine
8 of not more than one hundred dollars.
