### AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEANS OF EGRESS FROM CERTAIN PLACES OF ASSEMBLY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 No law, rule or regulation requiring the lighting of  
2 exits in places of assembly shall apply to buildings  
3 wherein not more than forty persons assemble; pro-  
4 vided, that the exits therein are plainly visible with-  
5 out lighting.
