RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF WILLIAM M. O'DONNELL OF
WESTFIELD.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging an
2 obligation of the commonwealth and after an appro-
3 priation has been made therefor, there be allowed and
4 paid from the treasury of the commonwealth to Wil-
5 liam M. O'Donnell of Westfield, the sum of forty-eight
6 hundred and sixteen dollars, in payment for certain
7 work done and materials furnished by the said Wil-
8 liam M. O'Donnell, in performance of the contract
9 dated October fifteenth, nineteen hundred and thirty-
10 eight, between the said William M. O'Donnell and
11 the commonwealth, on the buildings and grounds at
12 the Westfield state teachers college.
