MEMORANDUM OF COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION PURSUANT TO GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 7, AS AMENDED, WITH RESPECT TO PETITION OF MARTIN E. ADAMO AND OTHERS FOR AMENDMENT OF THE ACT OF 1943 AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE BOSTON SCHOOL OF PHARMACY TO GRANT THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN PHARMACY.

FEBRUARY 2, 1945.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.

The above-named petition was transmitted to me by the Clerk of the House January 16, 1945. Pursuant to notification by me an amendment of the petition was filed with me for the purpose of indicating why the object sought by the petition cannot be accomplished under the General Laws. This amendment is enclosed herewith.

The Boston School of Pharmacy was organized as a corporation under General Laws, chapter 180, on December 30, 1940.

The petition seeks legislation to obviate compliance with the requirements of the Board of Collegiate Authority established by chapter 549 of the Acts of 1943. It would seem clear that the legislature alone can set aside these requirements if it shall deem it good policy to do

so. It is suggested that the opinion of the Board of Collegiate Authority may be desired in respect to the proposal.

No fee is required under General Laws, chapter 3, section 7 in the case of a corporation of this kind.

AN ACT AMENDING CHAPTER FIVE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE OF THE ACTS AND RESOLVES OF NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE WHEN THE TRUSTEES OF THE BOSTON SCHOOL OF PHARMACY WERE AUTHORIZED TO GRANT DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN PHARMACY UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter five hundred and seventy-one of the acts
2 and resolves of the year nineteen hundred and forty-
3 three is hereby amended by striking out the last four
4 words of the fourth line, and the fifth, sixth, and
5 seventh lines; that is, striking out the following: —
6 “if and when said school complies with the require-
7 ment of the board of collegiate authorities established
8 by chapter five hundred and forty-nine of the acts
9 of nineteen hundred and forty-three.”, so that the
10 said chapter five hundred and seventy-one of the
11 acts and resolves of nineteen hundred and forty-three
12 will read as follows:— The trustees of The Boston
13 School of Pharmacy, a corporation organized under
14 chapter one hundred and eighty of the General Laws,
15 are hereby authorized to confer the degree of Bache-
16 lor of Science in Pharmacy.
