AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO PAY A SUM
OF MONEY TO JOHN J. CONNORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation, the city of Boston may pay to John J.
3 Connors of said city a sum not exceeding two hun-
4 dred and five dollars for property damage to his motor
5 vehicle resulting from the negligent operation of a
6 motor vehicle owned by the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city,
3 subject to the provisions of its charter.
