AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HINGHAM TO PENSION WILLIAM L. FOSTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the pub-
2 lic good and in consideration of his long and merito-
3 rious service, the town of Hingham, acting by its
4 board of selectmen, may retire William L. Foster,
5 who served the town faithfully for forty years as a
6 member of its board of selectmen and in various other
7 capacities, on an annual pension, payable monthly,
8 equal to one half the salary received by him at the
9 time of the termination of his active service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the registered voters of said town at an
3 annual or special town meeting.
