AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE EMERGENCY PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE ERECTION OF A STATE OFFICE BUILDING IN THE VICINITY OF THE STATE HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The emergency public works commission, established
2 by section one of chapter three hundred and sixty-five
3 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-three, is
4 hereby authorized and directed to prepare a plan for
5 the construction of a state office building in the vicinity
6 of the state house. Said commission shall recommend
7 a site or sites and prepare plans and specifications for
8 the construction of said building, and may expend
9 therefor such sums as may hereafter be appropriated
10 therefor. Said commission may request and shall
11 receive from the several officers, departments, boards
12 and commissions of the commonwealth such assistance
13 as it may require for the adequate preparation of such
14 plans and specifications. Said commission shall make
15 its report to the general court by filing the same with
16 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before
17 the first Wednesday of December in the current year,
18 accompanied by such plans, specifications and drafts
19 of legislation as may be necessary to carry said recom-
20 mendations into effect.
