## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FORM, CONTENTS AND APPROVAL  
OF POLICIES OF ACCIDENT AND HEALTH INSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Section one hundred and eight of chapter one hun-  
2 dred and seventy-five of the General Laws, as appear-  
3 ing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended  
4 by adding at the end the following paragraph: —

5 Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent the  
6 approval and use of a policy containing multiple bene-  
7 fits and the provisions applicable thereto; provided,  
8 that such policy otherwise complies with the provi-  
9 sions of this section, and, provided further, that the  
10 schedule of benefits be set forth on the first page of  
11 the policy, and, further provided, that there shall  
12 appear on the filing back of the policy and also on  
13 the first page thereof in type not smaller than eighteen  
14 point or great primer, a reference to such schedule of  
15 benefits.
