By Mr. Wood of Easton, petition of Albert E. Wood (in accordance with the vote of the town of Norton) that said town be authorized to pay certain sums of money for property taken by the county commissioners of Bristol County for highway purposes. Municipal Finance (Joint).

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NORTON TO PAY CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY AS FULL COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN PROPERTY TAKEN BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BRISTOL COUNTY FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation, the town of Norton is hereby authorized
3 to pay to the parties and in the amounts hereinafter
4 specified, as full compensation for certain property
5 taken by eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine
6 of the General Laws by the county commissioners of
7 Bristol county for the construction of Bay road, so
8 called, in said town:
