Chap. 548. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SHERBORN TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL FUND FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCUMULATED, UNUSED SICK LEAVE GRANTED PURSUANT TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO BY THE TOWN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Sherborn is hereby authorized to establish a separate fund and to appropriate in any one year an

amount of money not exceeding one per cent of the amount raised in the preceding year by taxation of real and personal property for the purpose of funding said separate fund for the purpose of paying accumulated, unused sick leave to town employees pursuant to collective bargaining agreements. Any interest earned on such monies shall be added to and become part of said separate fund.

SECTION 2. The treasurer of the town of Sherborn shall be the custodian of such separate fund and may deposit the proceeds in national banks, or invest the proceeds by deposit in savings banks, co-operative banks or trust companies, organized under the laws of the commonwealth, or invest the same in such securities as are legal for the investment of funds of savings banks under the laws of the commonwealth, or in federal savings and loan associations situated in the commonwealth.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 549. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE ON INTER-STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 95 OVER UNITED STATES HIGHWAY ROUTE 1-A IN THE CITY OF ATTLEBORO AS THE CORPORAL ROBERT T. TAYLOR MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The bridge on Interstate highway route 95 over United States highway route 1-A in the city of Attleboro shall be designated and known as the Corporal Robert T. Taylor Memorial bridge, in memory of Robert T. Taylor, who was killed in action in the service of his country in the Vietnam conflict on February twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and seventy.

Suitable markers bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of said department, and as authorized by the Federal Highway Administration.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 550. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN PUBLIC LANDS IN THE CITY OF WOBURN FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES.
