AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE THREE RIVERS FIRE DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF PALMER TO BORROW FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A WATER SUPPLY, STORAGE AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of establishing a
2 water supply, storage and distribution facilities, the
3 Three Rivers Fire District of the town of Palmer may
4 borrow from time to time, within a period of five
5 years from the passage of this act, such sums as
6 may be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate
7 twenty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or
8 notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the
9 words, Three Rivers Fire District Loan, Act of 1945.
10 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate
11 loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more than
12 thirty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred

13 under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit,
14 but shall, except as provided herein, be subject to
15 chapter forty-four of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
