HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, July 16, 1945.

The committee on Ways and Means, to whom were referred the Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission of the advisability of the establishment of a state university, including a medical school, a dental school, a veterinary school and a school of osteopathy (Senate, No. 551, amended), the Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission to determine the proper division of responsibility, as between the Commonwealth and its political subdivisions, for the support of public education within the Commonwealth (House, No. 911, changed), the Resolve providing for an investigation by a special commission relative to the advisability of making the election or appointment of persons as school teachers subject to certification by the Department of Education as to their qualifications (House, No. 1809), and the Resolve providing for an investigation by a special commission relative to the advisability of abolishing the Advisory Board of Education in the Department of Education and establishing in lieu thereof in said department the Massachusetts Board of Education (House, No. 1812), report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 2146).

### RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF CERTAIN MATTERS RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION.

1    *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to  
2 consist of one member of the senate to be designated  
3 by the president thereof, three members of the house  
4 of representatives to be designated by the speaker  
5 thereof and three persons to be appointed by the  
6 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of  
7 making an investigation of the subject matter of the  
8 investigation referred to in the resolve providing for  
9 an investigation by a special commission of the ad-  
10 visability of the establishment of a State University  
11 including a medical school, a dental school, a veteri-  
12 nary school and a school of osteopathy (printed as  
13 current senate document numbered five hundred and  
14 fifty-one), the subject matter of the investigation re-  
15 ferred to in the resolve providing for an investigation  
16 by a special commission to determine the proper  
17 division of responsibility, as between the common-  
18 wealth and its political subdivisions, for the support  
19 of public education within the commonwealth (printed  
20 as current house document numbered nine hundred  
21 and eleven), the subject matter of the investigation  
22 referred to in the resolve providing for an investiga-  
23 tion by a special commission relative to the advisa-

24 bility of making the election or appointment of persons  
25 as school teachers subject to certification by the  
26 department of education as to their qualifications  
27 (printed as current house document numbered eight-  
28 een hundred and nine), and the subject matter of the  
29 investigation referred to in the resolve providing for  
30 an investigation by a special commission relative to  
31 the advisability of abolishing the advisory board of  
32 education in the department of education and estab-  
33 lishing in lieu thereof in said department the Massa-  
34 chusetts board of education (printed as current house  
35 document numbered eighteen hundred and twelve).  
36 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in  
37 the state house or elsewhere and may expend for  
38 clerical and other expenses such sums, not exceeding,  
39 in the aggregate, one thousand dollars, as may here-  
40 after be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall  
41 report to the general court the results of its investiga-  
42 tion, and its recommendations, if any, together with  
43 drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-  
44 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the  
45 clerk of the house of representatives on or before the  
46 first Wednesday of December in the current year.
