AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF A PARKING AREA IN THE CITY OF REVERE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized to establish and maintain a parking space
3 for motor vehicles on such land in the city of Revere
4 on the westerly side of Ocean avenue between Eliot
5 circle and Revere street and the easterly boundary
6 line of the Boston, Revere Beach and Lynn Railroad
7 property as may be transferred to the commonwealth
8 without cost to it. Suitable fees may be charged for
9 the use of said parking space or free parking may be
10 permitted thereat.
