To accompany the petition of J. Walton Tuttle and another for legislation to further regulate the hours of sale of liquor by package stores, so called. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Five.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE HOURS OF SALE OF LIQUOR BY PACKAGE STORES, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fifteen of chapter one hundred and thirty-
2 eight of the General Laws, as most recently amended
3 by chapter three hundred and fifty-three of the acts
4 of nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, is hereby
5 further amended by striking out the last sentence
6 appearing in said chapter three hundred and fifty-
7 three and inserting in place thereof the following
8 sentence:— Any holder of a license under this sec-
9 tion shall be permitted to make sales in accordance
10 with the terms of his license at any time between
11 nine o'clock ante meridian and nine o'clock post
12 meridian, or between nine o'clock ante meridian and
13 half past eleven o'clock post meridian on any day
14 immediately preceding a legal holiday, except when
15 prohibited by section thirty-three.
