To accompany the petition of J. Walton Tuttle and Battista J. Guareno for legislation to further regulate the performance of electrical work. Mercantile Affairs.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Five.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PERFORMANCE OF ELECTRICAL WORK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and eight of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three is hereby
3 repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Section one of chapter one hundred
2 and forty-one of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by inserting, in the fourth and fifth lines, the words:—
4 , either as master electrician or as journeyman elec-
5 trician,— so that the first paragraph will read as
6 follows:— No person, firm or corporation shall enter
7 into, engage in, or work at the business of installing
8 wires, conduits, apparatus, fixtures or other appliances
9 for carrying or using electricity for light, heat or
10 power purposes, either as master electrician or as

11 journeyman electrician, unless such person, firm or
12 corporation shall have received a license and a cer-
13 tificate therefor, issued by the state examiners of
14 electricians and in accordance with the provisions
15 hereinafter set forth.
