AN ACT RELATIVE TO EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE BAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter two hundred and twenty-one of the Gen-
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section
3 thirty-six, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,
4 the following section:—

5 *Section 36A.* No rule which requires that an
6 applicant for admission to the bar shall have com-
7 pleted more than a high school education shall be
8 valid as against any such applicant as to his general
9 education.
