**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO TAKE FOR PUBLIC USE THE TATMAN CEMETERY BURIAL GROUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Worcester is hereby au-  
2 thorized to take the tract of land on Greenwood street  
3 in said city, known as the Tatman cemetery, for the  
4 purposes of a public park, and it shall be added to the  
5 area known as Greenwood park, upon removing the  
6 remains of Revolutionary and Civil War dead, and  
7 the remains of any other dead in the private cemetery  
8 known as Tatman cemetery at the entrance of Green-  
9 wood park in the city of Worcester, and re-interring  
10 the same in suitable graves in Hope cemetery in  
11 the city of Worcester, as provided for by General  
12 Laws, chapter one hundred and fourteen, section  
13 seventeen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon ac-  
2 ceptance thereof by the city council of the city of  
3 Worcester.
