To accompany the petition of Edward C. Stone that provision be made for putting into effect modern forest management practices by the Department of Conservation in the Myles Standish State Forest and the Nickerson State Forest or Park. Conservation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PUTTING INTO EFFECT MODERN FOREST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION IN THE MYLES STANDISH STATE FOREST IN THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH AND THE NICKERSON STATE FOREST OR PARK IN THE COUNTY OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of conservation is
2 hereby authorized and directed to put into effect
3 modern forest management practices in the Myles
4 Standish State Forest in the county of Plymouth and
5 in the Nickerson State Forest or Park in the county
6 of Barnstable, so that the wooded areas or forests in
7 said two forests be in perpetuity turned into income-
8 producing forestry areas by the use of modern forest
9 management practices.

1 SECTION 2. For the work authorized in section one
2 of this act the sum of dollars is hereby
3 appropriated.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
