## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COMMISSION ON ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE IN CO-OPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION BE AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT COURSES FOR PROVIDING IN-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commission on administration and finance, in  
2 co-operation with the department of education, is  
3 hereby authorized and directed to establish and con-  
4 duct in-service training programs for persons employed  
5 by the commonwealth. The employees entitled to  
6 take such instruction shall be approved for the courses  
7 by their respective department or division head on the  
8 basis that such instruction will be of assistance in in-  
9 doctrinating or training the employees. The commis-  
10 sion on administration and finance, in co-operation  
11 with the department of education, may, in accordance

12 with rules and regulations established by them, grant  
13 to students satisfactorily completing such courses  
14 suitable certificates. The commonwealth may accept  
15 and use such federal funds as may be available for  
16 the purposes of this section.
