

# SENATE . . . . No. 147

To accompany the petition of Andrew P. Quigley that the Department of Public Works be authorized to extend the existing sea wall at Point Shirley in the town of Winthrop. Harbors and Public Lands.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE EXISTING SEA WALL AT POINT SHIRLEY IN THE TOWN OF WINTHROP.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is  
2 hereby authorized and directed to extend the present  
3 sea wall at Point Shirley in the town of Winthrop,  
4 and may expend for such purpose such sum as may  
5 hereafter be appropriated therefor, subject to con-  
6 ditions herein imposed. Said project shall not be  
7 commenced unless and until said town shall have  
8 deposited with the state treasurer one half of the  
9 estimated cost of such project, and shall have assumed  
10 liability, in the manner provided by section twenty-  
11 nine of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws, for all  
12 damages that may be incurred under said project, and  
13 has given satisfactory assurance that conditions im-  
14 posed upon said town of Winthrop with respect to

15 said project will be met. If any of the aforesaid sum  
16 contributed by the town of Winthrop remains after  
17 the completion of such project, such unexpended bal-  
18 ance shall be repaid to the town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by vote of the town of Winthrop in annual  
3 or special town meeting, and the filing in the office  
4 of said department of a certified copy of said vote.
