AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEANING OF THE WORDS "PERSON" AND "WHOEVER" AS USED IN THE GENERAL LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out clause Twenty-third, as ap-
3 pearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting
4 in place thereof the following clause:—
5 Twenty-third, "Person" or "whoever" shall in-
6 clude corporations, municipal corporations, societies,
7 associations and partnerships.
