AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RECEIPT OF COMPLAINTS AND THE ISSUANCE OF A SUMMONS, PROCESS OR WARRANT BY JUSTICES OF THE PEACE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 262 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the paragraph
3 amended by chapter 129 of the acts of 1949, and in-
4 serting in place thereof the following paragraph:—
5 For receiving a complaint under section thirty-six
6 of chapter two hundred and eighteen, three dollars:
7 and for issuing a summons, process or warrant under
8 said section, two dollars, except that when more than
9 one summons shall be simultaneously issued against
10 a single defendant, no fee shall be paid for such sum-
11 mons other than the first one.
