To accompany the petition of Daniel F. O'Brien that provision be made to increase the salaries of the chief justice and the associate justices of the Supreme Judicial Court and the chief justice and associate justices of the Superior Court. The Judiciary.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE AND THE ASSOCIATE JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT, AND THE CHIEF JUSTICE AND THE ASSOCIATE JUSTICES OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 211 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out section 22, as amended
3 by section 1 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1946, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following section:—
5 *Section 22.* The chief justice of the court shall re-
6 ceive a salary of nineteen thousand dollars and each
7 associate justice a salary of eighteen thousand dollars,
8 and the chief justice and each associate justice shall
9 annually receive from the commonwealth, upon cer-
10 tificate of the chief justice, the amount of the expenses
11 incurred by them in the discharge of their duties.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 212 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out section 27, as amended
3 by section 2 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1946, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following section:—
5 *Section 27.* The chief justice shall receive a salary
6 of sixteen thousand five hundred dollars and each
7 associate justice a salary of fifteen thousand five hun-
8 dred dollars, and the chief justice and each associate
9 justice shall annually receive from the commonwealth,
10 upon the certificate of the chief justice, the amount
11 of the expense incurred by them in the discharge of
12 their duties.
