To accompany the petition of Andrew B. Holstrom, mayor of Worcester, for legislation relative to the installation of parking meters in off-street parking lots and use of receipts therefrom. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSTALLATION OF PARKING METERS IN OFF-STREET PARKING LOTS AND USE OF THE RECEIPTS THEREFROM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22B of chapter 40 of the General Laws,
2 inserted by chapter 776 of the acts of 1949, is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end the following para-
4 graph:—

5 Any city or town, having installed parking meters
6 under the provisions of section twenty-two A, may
7 install said parking meters in municipally owned off-
8 street parking lots, and may use any receipts from
9 parking meters so installed for the purpose of pur-
10 chase of additional such parking lots, the care and
11 maintenance of the same, and in general for any
12 traffic control or traffic safety purposes, including
13 payment for public liability coverage in connection
14 with the use of said municipally owned off-street
15 parking lots.
