To accompany the petition of the city of Holyoke Gas and Electric Department, by Hugh J. Lacey, for legislation to authorize the use by the municipal gas and electric commission of said city of certain park lands for a gate station for natural gas supply. Power and Light.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE USE BY THE MUNICIPAL GAS AND ELECTRIC COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE OF CERTAIN LANDS ACQUIRED BY SAID CITY FOR PARK AND RECREATION PURPOSES FOR A GATE STATION FOR NATURAL GAS SUPPLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Holyoke, acting through its
2 park and recreation commission, and upon terms satis-
3 factory to said commission, may transfer the control
4 of certain lands hereinafter described, which were
5 acquired for park and recreation purposes, to the
6 municipal gas and electric commission of said city for
7 use by said municipal gas and electric commission
8 for a gate station for natural gas supply. Said transfer
9 shall be effected by vote of said parks and recreation
10 commission specifying the terms and conditions of the
11 transfer, and a vote of said municipal gas and electric

12 commission accepting said transfer, subject to the
13 terms and conditions stated therein. Copies of the
14 said votes, duly certified and acknowledged by the
15 secretary of each of said commissions, shall be recorded
16 in the registry of deeds for Hampden county, and,
17 upon such recording, the lands hereinafter described
18 need no longer be used for park or recreation purposes,
19 or be subject to the provisions of chapter forty-five of
20 the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The real estate referred to in section
2 one of this act is described as follows:

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by the park and recreation commission
3 of said city and by the board of aldermen thereof,
4 subject to the provisions of its charter, but not other-
5 wise.
