

Chap. 17. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SERVICE OF PROCESS UNDER THE UNIFORM RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF SUPPORT ACT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 273A of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 239 of the acts of 1958, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence: — Any officer authorized under the laws of the commonwealth to serve criminal process may serve any process under this chapter.

SECTION 2. Section 9 of said chapter 273A is hereby amended by striking out the third sentence, inserted by chapter 74 of the acts of 1957.

Chap. 18. AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH SOLDIERS AND SAILORS AND THEIR WIVES, WIDOWS, FATHERS AND MOTHERS MAY FILE APPLICATIONS FOR CERTAIN ABATEMENTS OR EXEMPTIONS OF TAXES LEVIED IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FOUR.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Application for abatement or exemption, as provided in clauses Twenty-second, Twenty-second A, Twenty-second B and Twenty-second C of section five of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws, of taxes levied in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-four may be made not later than October first, nineteen hundred and sixty-five notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary.

Chap. 19. AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR JAMES J. MORAN, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SURVEYOR OF THE TOWN OF MONSON.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The tenure of office of James J. Moran, incumbent of the office of highway surveyor of the town of Monson shall, upon the effective date of this act, be unlimited, but he may be removed therefrom for cause after hearing in the manner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the voters of the town of Monson at its annual town meeting to be held in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-six in the form of the following question, which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers at said meeting: — “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-five, entitled ‘An Act providing life tenure for James J. Moran, incumbent of the office of highway surveyor of the town of Monson’, be accepted?” If a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the affirmative, this act shall thereupon take full effect, but not otherwise.
