## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF BERTHA E. DAVIS UNDER THE STATE-BOSTON RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The retirement allowance of Bertha E. Davis, who  
2 was retired on August thirty-first, nineteen hundred  
3 and forty-nine, under the state-Boston retirement sys-  
4 tem, shall, from and after July first, nineteen hundred  
5 and forty-nine, be computed as if the provisions of  
6 paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section five of  
7 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as amended  
8 by chapters six hundred and fifty-six and six hundred  
9 and seventy-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
10 forty-nine, had been in effect at the time of her re-  
11 tirement. Such retirement allowance hereunder shall  
12 be in lieu of any additional amounts payable under  
13 chapter eight hundred and twenty of the acts of nine-  
14 teen hundred and fifty.
