### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF WINIFRED SAVELA OF FITCHBURG.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a  
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth and after an  
3 appropriation has been made therefor, there be  
4 allowed and paid out of the state treasury the sum of  
5 ten thousand dollars to Winifred Savela of Fitchburg  
6 whose beloved husband Alje M. Savela was murdered  
7 while on duty as a member of the state police patrolling  
8 route numbered one hundred and twenty-two in  
9 Barre on the night of August thirty-first, nineteen  
10 hundred and fifty-one. No payment shall be made  
11 hereunder until there has been filed with the comp-  
12 troller an affidavit signed by said Winifred Savela  
13 that no money has been paid to anyone to secure the  
14 passage of this resolve.
