## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Seven.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of the law to the contrary,  
2 the cities of Boston, Chelsea and Revere and the town of  
3 Winthrop shall contribute to the payment of the expenses  
4 of Suffolk county in the following proportion:—

	Per Cent.
City of Boston . . . . .	87.5
City of Chelsea . . . . .	5
City of Revere . . . . .	5
Town of Winthrop . . . . .	2.5
