AN ACT TO TRY TO PREVENT JUVENILE DELINQUENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 and elementary school children not to use profanity; thrift,
- 4 frugality and money management; to have respect for the
- 5 rights of others, and to inspire them with high ideals in at-
