### AN ACT PROHIBITING THE DISPLAY OF ADVERTISING MATERIAL ON THE OUTSIDE OF BUSES TRANSPORTING SCHOOL CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following new  
3 clause: —

4 (8) No advertising material shall be displayed on the out-  
5 side of such bus when it is being used for the transportation of  
6 school children.
