AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE NORTH BANK OF THE MERRIMACK RIVER ALONG THE PAWTUCKET BOULEVARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to protect and improve the north bank of the Merri-
3 mack river along the Pawtucket boulevard so called. For
4 said purposes, said department may expend such sums as may
5 be appropriated therefor.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year 1852 and 1853

The Act providing for the preservation and improvement of the
 the State of Massachusetts, and also for the better
 the State of Massachusetts.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
 General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
 in Session held at Boston.

1. The Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and
 empowered to purchase and to acquire the north bank of the State
 and west along the Eastern Railroad as called for
 and purposes and purposes may be deemed such purposes
 to be a public use.
