AN ACT PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATORY MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE RATES BASED UPON AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the first sentence of the first para-
3 graph thereof the following sentence: — He shall not establish
4 classifications of risks and premium charges for compulsory
5 motor vehicle insurance based upon the age of the operator.
