AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF MOVING COSTS BY THE BOSTON HOUSING AUTHORITY TO ANY PERSON FORCED TO VACATE HIS PREMISES BECAUSE OF THE TAKING OF SAID PREMISES IN CONNECTION WITH THE URBAN REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Boston Housing Authority is authorized
2 and directed to pay the cost of moving to a new location of
3 any person forced to vacate his premises because of the taking
4 of his home in connection with the urban redevelopment pro-
5 gram. Said payment shall, in no event, be less than four
6 hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
