AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AGE REQUIREMENT FOR PENSIONS,
RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES AND ANNUITIES TO CERTAIN FORMER
PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend
2 to defeat its purpose which is to make available to certain
3 former public employees the benefit of pensions, retirement
4 allowances and annuities, therefore it is hereby declared to
5 be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preser-
6 vation of the public welfare and convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 670 of the acts of 1955, as amended
2 by section 1 of chapter 415 of the acts of 1956, is hereby fur-
3 ther amended by striking out in line 10, the word "sixty"
4 and inserting in place thereof the word: — fifty-eight.
