## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Seven.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF ASSISTANCE TO THE BLIND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The director of the division of the blind shall  
2 include in the budget of each recipient of aid to the blind an  
3 item, to be known as "Transportation Activities", under  
4 which there shall be paid to each such recipient, in addition  
5 to any other sum paid to him, the sum of five dollars monthly.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January first,  
2 nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and shall remain in effect  
3 for a period of two years from said date.

## The Commission of Massachusetts

in the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen

As the Legislature in the Session of September, to wit:

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The officers of the division of the land shall include in the budget of each year in aid to the land office, to be known as "Transportation Expenses," such items as shall be paid for each such year, in addition to the amount paid in the year of the last number.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and shall remain in effect for a period of two years from said date.
