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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Seven.

AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS IN THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The office of superintendent of public buildings  
2 of the city of Pittsfield shall, upon the effective date of this  
3 act, become subject to the civil service laws and rules, and  
4 the tenure of office of the incumbent thereof shall be unlimited,  
5 subject, however, to said laws. The incumbent of said office  
6 on said effective date shall be subjected to a qualifying exami-  
7 nation for said office by the division of civil service. If said  
8 incumbent passes said examination he shall be certified for  
9 said office and shall be deemed to be permanently appointed  
10 thereto without serving any probationary period, and his  
11 tenure of office shall be unlimited, subject, however, to the  
12 provisions of said laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its accept-  
2 ance by the mayor and city council in the current year, but  
3 not otherwise.

## The Commission of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMMISSION OF MASSACHUSETTS TO INVESTIGATE THE STATE OF THE CITY OF BOSTON, AND TO REPORT THEREON TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Section 1. The name of the commission shall be the Commission of Massachusetts to Investigate the State of the City of Boston, and the office of the said commission shall be the office of the Mayor of the City of Boston, in that city.
2. The term of office of the said commission shall be two years.
3. The said commission shall be subject to a report to the Senate and House of Representatives by the Mayor of the City of Boston, at the end of the said term.
