AN ACT MAKING AMOUNT OF FINE DISCRETIONARY INSTEAD OF
MANDATORY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 Section 20 of Chapter 90 shall be amended by striking out
2 the words "not less" and inserting in place thereof the words:
3 — not more, — so that the part of the section referred to shall
4 read: — and that any person convicted of a violation of
5 section nineteen A or of any of the terms of any permit granted
6 thereunder shall be punished by a fine of not more than ten
7 dollars for each one thousand pounds of weight by which the
8 gross weight of such vehicle as operated exceeds either that
9 permitted by said section nineteen A or the gross weight for
10 which such vehicle is registered, but in no event more than
11 five hundred dollars.
