### AN ACT TO PROMOTE THE SAFETY OF PERSONS WORKING IN INDUSTRY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 28 thereof and substituting in its place  
3 the following section:—  
4 *Section 28.* If the employee is injured by reason of a vio-  
5 lation of any provision of chapter one hundred and forty-  
6 nine, sections one through eighteen, sections forty-five through  
7 one hundred and five, sections one hundred and six through  
8 one hundred and forty-seven H, or any rule, regulation or  
9 order made by the department of labor and industries, or  
10 any employee or subdivision thereof, in accordance with the  
11 provisions of said chapter for the prevention of accidents or  
12 industrial or occupational diseases, or by reason of the serious  
13 and wilful misconduct of an employer or of any person regu-  
14 larly intrusted with and exercising the powers of superintend-  
15 ence, the amounts of compensation hereinafter provided shall  
16 be doubled. In case the employer is insured, he shall repay  
17 to the insurer the extra compensation paid to the employee.  
18 If a claim is made under this section, and the employer is  
19 insured, the employer may appear and defend against such  
20 claim only. The employment of any minor, known to be  
21 such, in violation of any provision of sections sixty to seventy-  
22 four, inclusive, or of section one hundred and four of chapter  
23 one hundred and forty-nine, shall constitute serious and wilful  
24 misconduct under this section.
