AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A RECREATIONAL AREA IN THE VICINITY OF THE SAUGUS IRON WORKS RESTORATION, SO CALLED, IN THE TOWN OF SAUGUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct and maintain a recreational area
3 in the vicinity of the Saugus Iron Works Restoration, so
4 called, in the town of Saugus. Said recreational area shall
5 include facilities for swimming and ice skating in a park which
6 shall be called Charles De Franzo park; said park shall be
7 provided with picnic tables, benches and a band stand. For
8 the foregoing purposes said commission may expend such
9 sums as may be appropriated therefor.

The Commission of Enquiry

1. The Commission of Enquiry shall be appointed by the House of Representatives.
2. The Commission shall consist of not more than five members, one of whom shall be the Speaker of the House.
3. The Commission shall have the honor of the rank of a cabinet minister.
4. The Commission shall have the right to call for and examine any document or paper in the possession or control of any department of the Government.
